# LOCAL RULES

## 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

- In or over any boundary ditch.
- Beyond any boundary fence or hedge.
- Beyond the nearest inside points at ground level of any line of white stakes denoting out of bounds.
- If the ball played lands on the public road, it is out of bounds. If the ball played comes to rest in bounds on the other side of the road the ball can be played.

## 2. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)

- All fixed sprinkler heads.
- All water hydrants.
- Internal bridges.
- Fixed seats and shelters.
- Pathways.

## 3. STONES IN BUNKERS are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1)

## 4. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

Water hazards are marked by yellow posts. Lateral water hazards are marked by red posts. Any dyke not marked by yellow stakes must be treated as a lateral water hazard.

## 5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Relief must be taken from areas designated as G.U.R.

- Areas encircled with white lines.
- Temporary greens.

## 6. TREES

Relief must be taken from staked trees in accordance with procedure as per rule 24.2 (b)

## 7. ETIQUETTE

Replace divots, repair pitchmarks, rake bunkers.

Litter should not be dropped on the course.

Avoid slow play. If you lose one clear hole, invite the players following to play through.

Golf carts must be kept away from greens and trees.
